- 10 how the voter voted, the person knowingly:

- 12 act; or
- 13 (2) with respect to a voter over whom the person has
- 14 authority in the scope of employment, subjects or threatens to
- 15 subject the voter to a loss or reduction of wages or another benefit
- 16 of employment.
