2	relating to including fetal development instruction as part of the
3	health curriculum used in public schools in certain grade levels.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (y) to read as follows:
7	(y) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules requiring
8	students enrolled in grade levels seven and eight to receive
9	instruction on fetal development as part of the essential knowledge
10	and skills for the health curriculum under Subsection (a)(2)(B).
11	The instruction must include:
12	(1) information on:
13	(A) the human reproductive process, pregnancy,
14	and infertility;
15	(B) establishing healthy life skills; and
16	(C) preventing birth defects, including
17	information on the effect of drugs, alcohol, and environmental
18	hazards, including lead; and
19	(2) a description of the growth and development of an
20	unborn child that occur during each trimester of pregnancy.
21	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
22	school year.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
