(B) the appointing agent, insurer, or health
maintenance organization completed a background check on the
applicant that shows that the applicant has not been convicted of:

5 (i) a felony; or

6 (ii) an act that requires the applicant to 7 receive written consent under 18 U.S.C. Section 1033 to engage in 8 the business of insurance;

9 (C) the applicant has not responded 10 affirmatively to any question on the license application that 11 indicates the applicant has a criminal conviction or has been 12 involved in an administrative action that may disqualify the 13 applicant from receiving a license; and

(D) the appointing agent, insurer, or health
 maintenance organization will supervise the work of the applicant.
 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
