1-22 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-23 AN ACT

1-24 relating to the new instructional facility allotment under the  
 1-25 foundation school program.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Sections 42.158(b), (d-1), and (g), Education  
 1-28 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-29 (b) For the first school year in which students attend a new  
 1-30 instructional facility, a school district is entitled to an  
 1-31 allotment of \$1,000 [~~\$250~~] for each student in average daily  
 1-32 attendance at the facility. For the second school year in which  
 1-33 students attend that instructional facility, a school district is  
 1-34 entitled to an allotment of \$1,000 [~~\$250~~] for each additional  
 1-35 student in average daily attendance at the facility.

1-36 (d-1) In addition to the appropriation amount described by  
 1-37 Subsection (d), the amount of \$1 million may be appropriated each  
 1-38 school year to supplement the allotment to which a school district  
 1-39 is entitled under this section that may be provided using the  
 1-40 appropriation amount described by Subsection (d). The commissioner  
 1-41 shall first apply the funds appropriated under this subsection to  
 1-42 prevent any reduction under Subsection (d) in the allotment for  
 1-43 attendance at an eligible high school instructional facility,  
 1-44 subject to the maximum amount of \$1,000 [~~\$250~~] for each student in  
 1-45 average daily attendance. Any funds remaining after preventing all  
 1-46 reductions in amounts due for high school instructional facilities  
 1-47 may be applied proportionally to all other eligible instructional  
 1-48 facilities, subject to the maximum amount of \$1,000 [~~\$250~~] for each  
 1-49 student in average daily attendance.

1-50 (g) In this section:

1-51 (1) "Instructional [~~instructional~~] facility" has  
 1-52 the meaning assigned by Section 46.001.

1-53 (2) "New instructional facility" includes:

- 1-54 (A) a newly constructed instructional facility;
- 1-55 (B) a repurposed instructional facility; and
- 1-56 (C) a leased facility operating for the first  
 1-57 time as an instructional facility with a minimum lease term of not  
 1-58 less than 10 years.

1-59 SECTION 2. A school district that is entitled under Section  
 1-60 42.158, Education Code, to receive funding in the 2017-2018 school

2-1 year for the second year of student attendance at a new  
2-2 instructional facility is entitled for that year to the amount  
2-3 provided for the second year of student attendance as a result of  
2-4 the changes in law made by this Act.

2-5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
