4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 43, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter Y to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER Y. CHARITY HUNT PERMIT
8	Sec. 43.961. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "charitable
9	nonprofit organization" means an organization that is exempt from
10	federal income taxation under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code
11	of 1986, by being listed as an exempt organization in Section
12	501(c)(3) of that code.
13	Sec. 43.962. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT. (a) A landowner may
14	apply to the department for a permit to host a charity hunt
15	occurring within two weeks after the end of an open hunting season
16	to raise money for a charitable nonprofit organization.
17	(b) The application for a permit to host a charity hunt must
18	include:
19	(1) the specific date of the hunt;
20	(2) the event name, if applicable; and
21	(3) the charitable nonprofit organization to which the
22	money derived from the hunt will be donated.
23	Sec. 43.963. PERMIT REQUIRED. No person may host a charity
24	hunt under this subchapter unless the person holds a valid permit to

1	host a charity hunt and a hunting license under Chapter 42.
2	Sec. 43.964. ISSUANCE OF PERMIT; FEE. (a) The department
3	may issue a permit to host a charity hunt under this subchapter.
4	(b) The fee for filing an application for a permit to host a
5	charity hunt is \$100. If the department denies the application and
6	the applicant elects not to proceed further, the department may
7	order any part of the fee submitted with the application returned to
8	the applicant.
9	Sec. 43.965. DONATION OF PROCEEDS. (a) The landowner shall
10	donate any proceeds the landowner receives from the charity hunt to
11	the charitable nonprofit organization.
12	(b) The department shall prescribe a form to be completed by
13	the charitable nonprofit organization to prove the organization's
14	status as a charitable nonprofit organization.
15	Sec. 43.966. RULES. The commission may adopt any rules
16	necessary to administer this subchapter.
17	SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2017, the Parks and
18	Wildlife Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
19	Subchapter Y, Chapter 43 , Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this
20	Act.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
