A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to providing a telephone number for certain governmental
3 purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 13.004(a) and (c), Election Code, are
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The registrar may ~~not~~ transcribe, copy, or otherwise
8 record a telephone number furnished on a registration application
9 only for purposes of reconstituting a jury wheel as provided by
10 Sections 62.001 and 62.002, Government Code.

11 (c) The following information furnished on a registration
12 application is confidential and does not constitute public
13 information for purposes of Chapter 552, Government Code:

14 (1) a social security number;

15 (2) a Texas driver's license number;

16 (3) a number of a personal identification card issued
17 by the Department of Public Safety;

18 (4) an indication that an applicant is interested in
19 working as an election judge; ~~or~~

20 (5) the residence address of the applicant, if the
21 applicant is a federal judge or state judge, as defined by Section
22 13.0021, the spouse of a federal judge or state judge, or an
23 individual to whom Section 552.1175, Government Code, applies and
24 the applicant:

1 (A) included an affidavit with the registration
2 application describing the applicant's status under this
3 subdivision, including an affidavit under Section 13.0021 if the
4 applicant is a federal judge or state judge or the spouse of a
5 federal judge or state judge;

6 (B) provided the registrar with an affidavit
7 describing the applicant's status under this subdivision,
8 including an affidavit under Section 15.0215 if the applicant is a
9 federal judge or state judge or the spouse of a federal judge or
10 state judge; or

11 (C) provided the registrar with a completed form
12 approved by the secretary of state for the purpose of notifying the
13 registrar of the applicant's status under this subdivision; or

14 (6) a telephone number.

15 SECTION 2. Section 18.066(b), Election Code, is amended to
16 read as follows:

17 (b) Information furnished under this section may not
18 include:

19 (1) a voter's social security number; [~~or~~]

20 (2) the residence address of a voter who is a federal
21 judge or state judge, as defined by Section 13.0021, or the spouse
22 of a federal judge or state judge, if the voter included an
23 affidavit with the voter's registration application under Section
24 13.0021 or the applicable registrar has received an affidavit
25 submitted under Section 15.0215; or

26 (3) a voter's telephone number.

27 SECTION 3. Sections 62.001(c) and (i), Government Code, are

1 amended to read as follows:

2 (c) Each year not later than the third Tuesday in November
3 or the date provided by Section 16.032, Election Code, for the
4 cancellation of voter registrations, whichever is earlier, the
5 voter registrar of each county shall furnish to the secretary of
6 state a current voter registration list from all the precincts in
7 the county that, except as provided by Subsection (d), includes:

8 (1) the complete name, mailing address, date of birth,
9 voter registration number, and precinct number for each voter;

10 (2) if available, the Texas driver's license number or
11 personal identification card or certificate number, ~~and~~ social
12 security number, and telephone number for each voter; and

13 (3) any other information included on the voter
14 registration list of the county.

15 (i) The commissioners court may, instead of using the method
16 provided by Subsections (c) through (h), contract with another
17 governmental unit or a private person to combine the voter
18 registration list with the list furnished by the Department of
19 Public Safety. Subsections (c) through (h) do not apply to a county
20 in which the commissioners court has contracted with another
21 governmental unit or a private person under this subsection. The
22 Department of Public Safety may not charge a fee for furnishing a
23 list under this subsection. Each list must contain the name, date
24 of birth, address, county of residence, and citizenship status of
25 each person listed and if available, the telephone number of each
26 person. If practical, each list must contain any other information
27 useful in determining if the person is qualified to serve as a

1 juror.

2 SECTION 4. Section 62.002, Government Code, is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 Sec. 62.002. JURY WHEEL CARDS. (a) The officials or their
5 deputies who reconstitute the jury wheel shall write on a separate
6 jury wheel card of uniform size and color the name and, if possible,
7 the post office address and telephone number of each prospective
8 juror that resides in the county and whose name appears on the
9 current lists used under Section 62.001. The name of each
10 prospective juror may appear on only one card.

11 (b) In a county with a population of 140,000 or more, the
12 commissioners court shall employ typists who shall type the names,
13 ~~and~~ addresses, and if available, telephone numbers of qualified
14 prospective jurors on separate jury wheel cards of uniform size and
15 color under the direction and control of the district clerk. The
16 expenses incurred in typing the names, ~~and~~ addresses, and
17 telephone numbers must be authorized, reported, and paid and
18 accounted for under the laws and rules that govern the payment of
19 other expenses of the office of district clerk. The compensation of
20 the typists and the expenses are paid from the jury fund.

21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
25 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
