1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to excluding a person on the suspense list from jury duty.  
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-21 SECTION 1. Section [62.001](#)(d), Government Code, is amended  
1-22 to read as follows:  
1-23 (d) The list required by Subsection [\(a\)\(1\)](#) must ~~[(c) may]~~  
1-24 ~~exclude[, at the option of the voter registrar of each county,]~~ the  
1-25 names of persons on the suspense list maintained under Section  
1-26 [15.081](#), Election Code.  
1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-29 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
