1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 62.001(d), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(d) The list required by Subsection (a)(1) must [(c) may] exclude [a, at the option of the voter registrar of each county, [a, at] the names of persons on the suspense list maintained under Section 15.081, Election Code.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
