- 2 relating to county regulation of roadside vendors and solicitors.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 285.001(a), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of
- 7 a county with a population of more than 1.3 million and a county
- 8 with a population of more than 550,000 that is adjacent to a county
- 9 with a population of four million by order may regulate the
- 10 following in the unincorporated area of the county if they occur on
- 11 a public highway or road, in the right-of-way of a public highway or
- 12 road, or in a parking lot:
- 13 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or
- 14 merchandise, including live animals;
- 15 (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a
- 16 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live
- 17 animals; and
- 18 (3) the solicitation of money.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
