A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to increasing the punishment for assault committed against

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.01(c), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (c) An offense under Subsection (a)(2) or (3) is a Class C
- 8 misdemeanor, except that the offense is:
- 9 (1) a Class A misdemeanor if the offense is committed
- 10 under Subsection (a)(3) against an elderly individual or disabled
- 11 individual, as those terms are defined by Section 22.04; or
- 12 (2) a Class B misdemeanor if the offense is committed
- 13 by <u>any</u> [a] person, other than [who is not] a sports participant who
- 14 is an athlete younger than 19 years of age, against another [a]
- 15 person the actor knows is a sports participant either:
- 16 (A) while the participant is performing duties or
- 17 responsibilities in the participant's capacity as a sports
- 18 participant; or
- 19 (B) in retaliation for or on account of the
- 20 participant's performance of a duty or responsibility within the
- 21 participant's capacity as a sports participant.
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 24 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is

- 1 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 3 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 4 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 5 before that date.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
