## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the definition of "affected person" for purposes of a
- 3 contested case hearing held by or for the Texas Commission on
- 4 Environmental Quality regarding certain environmental permit
- 5 applications.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 5.115(a), Water Code, is amended to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (a) For the purpose of an administrative hearing held by or
- 10 for the commission involving a contested case, "affected person,"
- 11 or "person affected," or "person who may be affected" means a person
- 12 who has a personal justiciable interest related to a legal right,
- 13 duty, privilege, power, or economic interest affected by the
- 14 administrative hearing. An interest common to members of the
- 15 general public does not qualify as a personal justiciable interest.
- 16 For the purpose of an administrative hearing held by or for the
- 17 commission involving a contested case regarding a permit
- 18 application referred under Section 5.556 or 5.557, the following
- 19 elected officials are considered affected persons:
- 20 (1) the state senator and representative who represent
- 21 the area in which the facility to which the application relates is
- 22 located or proposed to be located;
- 23 <u>(2) the members of the governing body of a</u>
- 24 municipality in which the facility to which the application relates

- 1 <u>is located or proposed to be located; and</u>
- 2 (3) the commissioners court of a county in which the
- 3 facility to which the application relates is located or proposed to
- 4 be located.
- 5 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 an application for a permit that is filed with the Texas Commission
- 7 on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 An application for a permit filed before the effective date of this
- 9 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of filing, and that
- 10 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
