- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 814.103, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (b) <u>and</u>
- 10 (c), the standard service retirement annuity for service credited
- 11 in the elected class of membership is an amount equal to the number
- 12 of years of service credit in that class, times two percent of the
- 13 state salary, excluding longevity pay payable under Section
- 14 659.0445 and as adjusted from time to time, being paid a district
- 15 judge.
- 16 (c) The standard service retirement annuity for service
- 17 credited in the elected class of membership all of which was earned
- 18 as a member of the legislature is an amount equal to the number of
- 19 years of service credit in that class, times two percent of
- 20 \$140,000.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to the standard service retirement annuity for a person who is first
- 23 eligible to become a member of the elected class on or after
- 24 September 1, 2017. A person who is first eligible to become a

- 1 member of the elected class before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 3 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 4 purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
