- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9721 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9721. ARCHITECTURE DEGREE PROGRAM INSTRUCTION IN
- 9 ACCESSIBLE DESIGN. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 10 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 11 (b) The governing board of each institution of higher
- 12 education that offers an undergraduate or graduate degree program
- 13 <u>in architecture shall include in the required curriculum for that</u>
- 14 degree program instruction regarding the requirements of the 2010
- 15 Americans with Disabilities Act Standards for Accessible Design or
- 16 any successor standards that address accessible design of buildings
- 17 or other facilities and are promulgated under the Americans with
- 18 Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. Section 12101 et seq.).
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an undergraduate or graduate degree program in architecture
- 21 offered by a public institution of higher education during an
- 22 academic period that begins on or after the effective date of this
- 23 Act.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
