Section 263.251(a), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The commissioners court of a county may adopt a procedure by which the county may: 8 lease to another entity advertising space located: 9 (1)in or on a building or part of a building 10 (A) 11 owned by the county; 12 (B) on personal property [a vehicle] owned by the 13 county; 14 (C) on an official county website; or 15 on personal property [a vehicle] leased by (D) the county, with the property [vehicle] owner's consent; or 16 sell advertising space located on correspondence 17 (2) distributed by the county through the United States Postal Service. 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
