- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 352, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 352.052 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 352.052. PROHIBITION ON FIREWORK USE DURING CERTAIN
- 8 HOURS. (a) In this section, "fireworks" means any composition or
- 9 device designed for entertainment to produce a visible or audible
- 10 effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration, or detonation.
- 11 (b) The commissioners court of a county by order may
- 12 prohibit the use of fireworks in the unincorporated area of the
- 13 county during the hours specified by the order. The order may
- 14 include:
- 15 (1) an exemption for holidays, including New Year's
- 16 Eve and July 4; and
- 17 (2) a process by which a person may apply to the county
- 18 for a permit to use fireworks during a time prohibited by the order.
- 19 <u>(c) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally</u>
- 20 or knowingly violates a prohibition adopted under this section by
- 21 the commissioners court. An offense under this subsection is a
- 22 Class C misdemeanor.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
