- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 2.32 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 2.32. PROHIBITED ACTS BY RESERVE LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 8 OFFICERS. (a) In this section:
- 9 <u>(1) "Private patrol vehicle" means a privately owned</u>
- 10 motor vehicle that is:
- 11 (A) marked with the word "police," "sheriff," or
- 12 <u>"constable"</u>; or

- 13 (B) equipped with a red, white, or blue beacon,
- 14 flashing, or alternating light.
- 15 (2) "Reserve law enforcement officer" has the meaning
- assigned by Section 1701.001, Occupations Code.
- 17 (b) A reserve law enforcement officer may not, for
- 18 compensation from a private business, use or operate a private
- 19 patrol vehicle, direct traffic on a public highway, or provide
- 20 <u>motor vehicle escort services:</u>
- 21 (1) outside the jurisdiction in which the reserve
- 22 officer is appointed or employed; or
- 23 (2) inside the jurisdiction in which the reserve
- 24 officer is appointed or employed, unless the reserve officer

- 1 receives permission from the reserve officer's appointing law
- 2 enforcement agency.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 1701.501(a), Occupations Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the commission
- 6 shall revoke or suspend a license, place on probation a person whose
- 7 license has been suspended, or reprimand a license holder for a
- 8 violation of:
- 9 (1) this chapter;
- 10 (2) the reporting requirements provided by Articles
- 11 2.132 and 2.134, Code of Criminal Procedure; [or]
- 12 (3) Article 2.32, Code of Criminal Procedure; or
- 13 (4) a commission rule.
- SECTION 3. Section 1702.130, Occupations Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 16 <u>(a-1)</u> While performing duties as a commissioned or
- 17 noncommissioned security officer, a reserve law enforcement
- 18 officer, as defined by Section 1701.001, may not:
- 19 (1) wear the official uniform of the reserve officer's
- 20 appointing law enforcement agency; or
- 21 (2) use any title, insignia, or identification card or
- 22 make any statement with the intent to give an impression that the
- 23 officer is a law enforcement officer.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
