A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the training period for a temporary insurance agent's 3 license.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 4001.160(a), Insurance Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

7 (a) An agent, insurer, or health maintenance organization 8 that is considering appointment of a temporary license applicant as 9 its agent shall provide at least 40 hours of training to the 10 applicant not later than the <u>30th</u> [14th] day after the date the 11 application, nonrefundable fee, and certificate are delivered or 12 mailed to the department.

13 SECTION 2. Section 4001.160(a), Insurance Code, as amended 14 by this Act, applies only with respect to an applicant for a temporary license whose application is delivered or mailed to the 15 Texas Department of Insurance on or after the effective date of this 16 Act. With respect to an applicant whose application is delivered or 17 mailed before that date, an agent, insurer, or health maintenance 18 organization is governed by the law as it existed immediately 19 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 20 21 effect for that purpose.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
