## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the charging instrument in the prosecution of the

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 21.151 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 21.151. RESISTING ARREST. The complaint, information,
- 8 or indictment in the prosecution of a criminal case in which a
- 9 person is alleged to have resisted arrest under Section 38.03,
- 10 Penal Code, must state the underlying offense for which the person
- 11 was resisting arrest.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a criminal case in which the complaint, information, or
- 14 indictment is presented to the court on or after the effective date
- 15 of this Act. A criminal case in which the complaint, information, or
- 16 indictment was presented to the court before the effective date of
- 17 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the complaint,
- 18 information, or indictment was presented, and the former law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
