## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.156(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) On the immediate approach of an authorized emergency
- 8 vehicle using audible and visual signals that meet the requirements
- 9 of Sections 547.305 and 547.702, or of a police vehicle lawfully
- 10 using [only] an audible or visual signal, an operator, unless
- 11 otherwise directed by a police officer, shall:
- 12 (1) yield the right-of-way;
- 13 (2) immediately drive to a position parallel to and as
- 14 close as possible to the right-hand edge or curb of the roadway
- 15 clear of any intersection; and
- 16 (3) stop and remain standing until the authorized
- 17 emergency vehicle has passed.
- SECTION 2. Section 546.002(b), Transportation Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 (b) <u>Sections 546.001(2)</u>, (3), and (4) apply [<del>Section</del>
- 21 546.001 applies only when the operator is:
- 22 (1) responding to an emergency call;
- 23 (2) pursuing an actual or suspected violator of the
- 24 law;

- 1 (3) responding to but not returning from a fire alarm;
- 2 (4) directing or diverting traffic for public safety
- 3 purposes; or
- 4 (5) conducting a police escort.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
