Section 545.156(a), Transportation Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) On the immediate approach of an authorized emergency vehicle using audible and visual signals that meet the requirements 8 of Sections 547.305 and 547.702, or of a police vehicle lawfully 9 using [only] an audible or visual signal, an operator, unless 10 11 otherwise directed by a police officer, shall: 12 (1)yield the right-of-way; 13 (2) immediately drive to a position parallel to and as 14 close as possible to the right-hand edge or curb of the roadway clear of any intersection; and 15 (3) stop and remain standing until the authorized 16 emergency vehicle has passed. 17 SECTION 2. Section 546.002(b), Transportation Code, 18 is amended to read as follows: 19 Sections 546.001(2), (3), and (4) apply [Section 20 (b) 21 546.001 applies] only when the operator is: (1)responding to an emergency call; 22 23 (2) pursuing an actual or suspected violator of the 24 law;

(3) responding to but not returning from a fire alarm;
(4) directing or diverting traffic for public safety
