A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to prohibiting the transfer of a firearm to a person listed in the terrorist screening database maintained by the Federal 3 Bureau of Investigation. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 46.06(a), Penal Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 8 (a) A person commits an offense if the person: 9 (1)sells, rents, leases, loans, or gives a handgun to any person knowing that the person to whom the handgun is to be 10 11 delivered intends to use it unlawfully or in the commission of an 12 unlawful act; 13 intentionally or knowingly sells, rents, leases, (2) 14 or gives or offers to sell, rent, lease, or give to any child younger than 18 years any firearm, club, or illegal knife; 15 intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly sells a 16 (3) firearm or ammunition for a firearm to any person who is 17 intoxicated; 18 knowingly sells a firearm or ammunition for a 19 (4)firearm to any person who has been convicted of a felony before the 20 21 fifth anniversary of the later of the following dates: 22 (A) the person's release from confinement 23 following conviction of the felony; or 24 (B) the person's release from supervision under

1 community supervision, parole, or mandatory supervision following

3 (5) sells, rents, leases, loans, or gives a handgun to 4 any person knowing that an active protective order is directed to 5 the person to whom the handgun is to be delivered; [or]

6 (6) knowingly purchases, rents, leases, or receives as 7 a loan or gift from another a handgun while an active protective 8 order is directed to the actor; or

9 <u>(7)</u> sells, rents, leases, loans, or gives a firearm to 10 <u>a person the name of whom the actor knows is included in the</u> 11 <u>terrorist screening database maintained by the Federal Bureau of</u> 12 <u>Investigation</u>.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 13 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 14 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 16 17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 18 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 19 before that date. 20
