## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the governance of public housing authorities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 392.031, Local Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 6 (b-1) A commissioner of the authority must reside in:
- 7 (1) the area over which the authority has
- 8 jurisdiction; or
- 9 (2) an area outside the jurisdiction of the authority,
- 10 as determined by the municipality.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 392.032(b), Local Government Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) A commissioner of the authority <u>must reside in the area</u>
- 14 over which the authority has jurisdiction [may not be an officer or
- 15 employee of the county].
- 16 SECTION 3. Section 392.033, Local Government Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:
- 18 <u>(d-1)</u> A commissioner of the authority who is appointed under
- 19 Subsection (a), (b), or (d) must reside in the county the
- 20 commissioner is appointed to represent. An additional commissioner
- 21 who is appointed under Subsection (c) may reside in either county in
- 22 the authority.
- SECTION 4. Section 392.0331, Local Government Code, is
- 24 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

- 1 (c-1) The commissioners court of a county that has a county
- 2 housing authority in which the total number of households served by
- 3 the authority is 150 or fewer is not required to appoint a tenant to
- 4 the position of commissioner as otherwise required by Subsection
- 5 (c) if the commissioners court has provided timely notice of a
- 6 vacancy in the position to all eligible tenants and is unable to
- 7 fill the position with an eligible tenant before the 60th day after
- 8 the date the position becomes vacant.
- 9 SECTION 5. Section 392.038, Local Government Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 392.038. OTHER OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF A MUNICIPAL
- 12 OR COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY. (a) A municipal or county housing
- 13 authority may:
- 14 (1) employ a secretary, who shall serve as executive
- 15 director;  $[\tau]$  and
- 16 (2) [may] employ technical experts and other officers
- 17 and  $[\tau]$  agents  $[\tau]$  and employees, permanent or temporary, the
- 18 authority considers necessary.
- 19 (b) The executive director [authority] shall:
- 20 (1) hire employees, permanent or temporary; and
- 21 <u>(2)</u> determine the qualifications, duties, and
- 22 compensation of those employees [the persons employed].
- SECTION 6. Section 392.0331(a), Local Government Code, is
- 24 repealed.
- 25 SECTION 7. (a) The term of a housing authority commissioner
- 26 who is serving immediately before the effective date of this Act and
- 27 who becomes ineligible to hold that position because of the changes

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- 1 in law made by this Act expires on the effective date of this Act.
- 2 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 3 Act, the appropriate appointing entity shall fill any vacancy in
- 4 the position of housing authority commissioner that occurs as
- 5 described by Subsection (a) of this section.
- 6 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
