- 2 SECTION 2. Section 707.017, Transportation Code, as amended
- 3 by this Act, applies only to a civil penalty imposed under Chapter
- 4 707, Transportation Code, on or after the effective date of this
- 5 Act. A civil penalty imposed before the effective date of this Act
- 6 is governed by the law in effect when the civil penalty was imposed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
