1 (5) a siren; 2 (6) the words "critical care transport," "emergency," "emergency medical services," or "mobile intensive care unit"; or 3 4 (7) the acronym "EMS" or "MICU". 5 (c) A person commits an offense if the person violates this section. An offense under this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor. 6 7 (d) This section does not apply to a motor vehicle bearing a license plate issued or approved under Section 504.501 or 504.502, Transportation Code.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
