19	SECTION 2. Article 13.045, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

22	An offense punishable by fine only that is committed on or near the
23	boundary[, or within 200 yards of the boundary,] of contiguous

1 Article 4.14(f) and Section 29.003(h), Government Code, may be 2 prosecuted in either of those municipalities <u>as provided in the</u> 3 agreement.

4 SECTION 3. Section 29.003(h), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

6 (h) A municipality with a population of 1.19 million or more 7 and another municipality contiguous to that municipality may enter 8 into an agreement providing concurrent jurisdiction for the 9 municipal courts of either jurisdiction for all criminal cases 10 arising from offenses under state law that are:

11 (1) committed on the boundary of those municipalities 12 or <u>in one or both of the following areas:</u>

13 (A) within 200 yards of that boundary; or 14 (B) within 2.25 miles of that boundary on a 15 segment of highway in the state highway system that traverses a 16 major water supply reservoir; and

17 (2) punishable by fine only.

18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
