A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the licensing and regulation of a journeyman lineman.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1305.002(12), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (12) "Journeyman lineman" means an individual who
- 7 engages in electrical work involving the <u>installation</u>,
- 8 maintenance, and operation of equipment associated with the
- 9 transmission and distribution of electricity from the
- 10 electricity's original source to a substation and from a substation
- 11 to the point where the electricity enters a building or structure on
- 12 <u>a customer's premises</u> for further distribution.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 1305.101(a), Occupations Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The executive director or commission, as appropriate,
- 16 shall:
- 17 (1) by rule establish the financial responsibility
- 18 requirements for electrical contractors; [and]
- 19 (2) after publication of the National Electrical Code
- 20 by the National Fire Protection Association every three years,
- 21 adopt the revised National Electrical Code as the electrical code
- 22 for the state; and
- 23 (3) after publication of the National Electrical
- 24 Safety Code by the Institute of Electrical and Electronics

- 1 Engineers every five years, adopt the revised National Electrical
- 2 Safety Code for purposes of Section 1305.162(e).
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 1305.162, Occupations Code, is amended
- 4 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 5 (e) In addition to the other requirements of this section,
- 6 the department shall accept, develop, or contract for a journeyman
- 7 lineman examination that tests an applicant's knowledge of:
- 8 (1) materials and methods used in the installation,
- 9 maintenance, and operation of equipment associated with the
- 10 transmission and distribution of electricity from the
- 11 electricity's original source to a substation and from a substation
- 12 to the point where the electricity enters a building or structure on
- 13 a customer's premises for further distribution; and
- 14 (2) the standards prescribed by the National
- 15 Electrical Safety Code as adopted by the commission.
- SECTION 4. Section 1305.162(e), Occupations Code, as added
- 17 by this Act, applies only to an examination for a journeyman lineman
- 18 license administered on or after June 1, 2018. An examination for a
- 19 journeyman lineman license administered before that date is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the examination was
- 21 administered, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 22 purpose.
- SECTION 5. Not later than March 1, 2018, the Texas
- 24 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules necessary
- 25 to implement Sections 1305.101(a)(3) and 1305.162(e), Occupations
- 26 Code, as added by this Act.
- 27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
