5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2001, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2001.0045 to read as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 2001.0045. REQUIREMENT FOR NEW RULE. (a) In this</u> 8 section, "state agency" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 9 2001.006.
- 10 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a state agency may
- 11 not adopt a proposed rule unless on or before the effective date of
- 12 the proposed rule the state agency repeals at least one state agency
- 13 rule.
- 14 (c) This section does not apply to the adoption of a rule:
- 15 (1) specifically required by the legislature; or
- 16 (2) necessary to protect the health and safety of the
- 17 residents of this state as authorized under the Health and Safety
- 18 <u>Code.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 2001.0045, Government Code, as added by
- 20 this Act, applies only to a rule proposed by a state agency on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act. A rule proposed before that
- 22 date is governed by the law in effect on the date the rule was
- 23 proposed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 24 purpose.
