14	(b) A magistrate shall release a defendant on personal bond
15	without sureties or other security, unless good cause is shown
16	otherwise, if the defendant:
17	(1) is pregnant; and

- (2) is not charged with and has not been previously 18
- convicted of a violent offense, as defined by Article 17.032(a). 19
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a person who is arrested on or after the effective date of this
- Act. A person arrested before the effective date of this Act is 22
- governed by the law in effect on the date the person was arrested, 23
- and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 24
