- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 556.0055, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 556.0055. [RESTRICTIONS ON] LOBBYING EXPENDITURES \underline{BY}
- 8 RECIPIENT OF STATE FUNDS PROHIBITED.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 556.0055(a), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (a) A political subdivision or private entity that receives
- 12 state funds may not [use the funds to] pay:
- 13 (1) lobbying expenses incurred by the recipient of the
- 14 funds;
- 15 (2) a person or entity that is required to register
- 16 with the Texas Ethics Commission under Chapter 305;
- 17 (3) any partner, employee, employer, relative,
- 18 contractor, consultant, or related entity of a person or entity
- 19 described by Subdivision (2); or
- 20 (4) a person or entity that has been hired to represent
- 21 associations or other entities for the purpose of affecting the
- 22 outcome of legislation, agency rules, ordinances, or other
- 23 government policies.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section

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- 1 556.0055(a), Government Code, applies to an expenditure made on or
- 2 after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
