- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 134.006(c), Education Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (c) In awarding a grant under this section, the commission
- 7 shall primarily consider the potential economic returns to the
- 8 state from the development of the career and technical education
- 9 course or program. The commission may also consider whether the
- 10 course or program:

- 11 (1) is part of a new, emerging industry or high-demand
- 12 occupation in the region served by the public junior college,
- 13 public technical institute, or independent school district, as
- 14 demonstrated by local labor market information;
- 15 (2) offers new or expanded dual credit career and
- 16 technical educational opportunities in public high schools; [or]
- 17 (3) is provided in cooperation with other public
- 18 junior colleges or public technical institutes across existing
- 19 service areas; or
- 20 <u>(4) includes career counseling and advising services</u>
- 21 for students.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with grants awarded
- 23 for the 2018-2019 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
