1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to information included in the curriculum of each driver
1-20 education course and driving safety course.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1001, Education Code, is
1-23 amended by adding Sections 1001.109 and 1001.1091 to read as
1-24 follows:

1-25 Sec. 1001.109. INFORMATION RELATING TO TRAFFIC STOPS. (a)
1-26 The commission by rule, in consultation with the Department of
1-27 Public Safety and regional leaders in driver education and law
1-28 enforcement appointed under Subsection (b), shall require that
1-29 information relating to law enforcement procedures for traffic
1-30 stops be included in the curriculum of each driver education and
1-31 driving safety course. The curriculum must include a demonstration
1-32 of the proper actions to be taken during a traffic stop and
1-33 information regarding appropriate interactions with law
1-34 enforcement.

1-35 (b) The advisory committee appointed under Section 1001.058
1-36 shall assist in the development of the driver education and driving
1-37 safety course curriculum requirements under Subsection (a).

1-38 Sec. 1001.1091. INFORMATION RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER
1-39 SAFETY SEAT SYSTEMS. The commission by rule shall require that
1-40 information relating to the proper use of child passenger safety
1-41 seat systems be included in the curriculum of each driver education
1-42 and driving safety course.

1-43 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than March 1, 2018, the Texas
1-44 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules
1-45 required by Sections 1001.109(a) and 1001.1091, Education Code, as
1-46 added by this Act.

1-47 (b) Not later than September 1, 2018, each provider of a
1-48 driver education course or driving safety course shall submit the
1-49 curriculum adopted pursuant to Sections 1001.109(a) and 1001.1091,
1-50 Education Code, as added by this Act, to the Texas Commission of
1-51 Licensing and Regulation for approval.

1-52 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
