1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

(d) An out-of-state political committee that does not file a 1-24 1-25 campaign treasurer appointment shall comply with Sections [Section] 254.1581, 254.161, and 254.261. SECTION 2. Section 254.161, Election Code, is amended to 1-26

1-27 1-28 read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 254.161. NOTICE TO CANDIDATE AND OFFICEHOLDER OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES. If a general-purpose committee 1-30 1-31 other than the principal political committee of a political party 1-32 or a political committee established by a political party's county executive committee accepts political contributions or makes political expenditures for a candidate or officeholder, notice of 1-33 1-34 1-35 that fact shall be given to the affected candidate or officeholder as provided by Section 254.128 for a specific-purpose committee. An out-of-state political committee that is required to comply with this section shall designate an officer of the committee to provide 1-36 1-37 1-38 the notice. 1-39
