## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the membership, powers, and duties of the Sunset
- 3 Advisory Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 325, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 325.0025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 325.0025. PURPOSE OF SUNSET ADVISORY COMMISSION. The
- 8 primary purpose of the commission is to review state agencies to
- 9 evaluate the need for the agency and determine whether the agency or
- 10 the agency's functions should be abolished or consolidated in
- 11 order to reduce the cost of state government operations.
- 12 SECTION 2. Sections 325.003(a) and (j), Government Code,
- 13 are amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) The Sunset Advisory Commission consists of five members
- of the senate and two [one] public members [member] appointed by the
- 16 lieutenant governor, [and] five members of the house of
- 17 representatives and two [ene] public members [member] appointed by
- 18 the speaker of the house, and one public member appointed by the
- 19 governor who may only vote on the commission's recommendations that
- 20 do not require a statutory change. The lieutenant governor and the
- 21 speaker of the house may serve as one of the legislative appointees.
- 22 (j) Eight [Seven] members of the commission constitute a
- 23 quorum. A final action or recommendation may not be made unless
- 24 approved by a record vote of a majority of members appointed by the

- 1 lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house. All other actions
- 2 by the commission shall be decided by a majority of the members
- 3 present and voting.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 325.015(a), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) During the regular session immediately before the
- 7 abolition of a state agency <u>and its</u> [<del>or an</del>] advisory <u>committees</u>
- 8 [committee] that are [is] subject to this chapter, the legislature
- 9 by law may continue the agency and any [or] advisory committee of
- 10 the agency for a period not to exceed:
- (1) eight years for an agency and any advisory
- 12 committee of the agency if the agency has 200 or more full-time
- 13 equivalent employees; and
- 14 (2) 10  $\left[\frac{12}{12}\right]$  years for an agency and any advisory
- 15 committee of the agency if the agency has less than 200 full-time
- 16 equivalent employees.
- 17 SECTION 4. The governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker
- 18 of the house of representatives, as soon as possible after the
- 19 effective date of this Act, shall appoint public members to serve
- 20 initial terms on the Sunset Advisory Commission under Section
- 21 325.003, Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
