5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 192.003, Election Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 192.003. METHOD OF BECOMING ELECTOR CANDIDATE. To 9 become a presidential elector candidate <u>or alternate elector</u>, a 10 person must be nominated as a political party's elector candidate 11 <u>or alternate elector</u> in accordance with party rules or named as an 12 elector candidate <u>or alternate elector</u> by an independent or 13 write-in candidate for president.

14 SECTION 2. Section 192.006, Election Code, is amended by 15 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 16 follows:

17 (a) The electors <u>and alternate electors</u> shall convene at the 18 State Capitol at 2 p.m. on the first Monday after the second 19 Wednesday in December following their election and shall perform 20 their duties as prescribed by federal law.

21 (d) An elector must cast a ballot for a candidate for 22 president or vice-president that corresponds to the candidates who 23 received the most votes cast in this state for those offices. An 24 attempt to cast a ballot in a manner other than the manner required

1 by this subsection: 2 (1) is not valid and is not considered a vote cast by 3 an elector; and 4 (2) creates a vacancy in the position of the elector 5 attempting to cast the ballot. SECTION 3. Section 192.007, Election Code, is amended by 6 7 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: (c) A replacement elector for a vacancy created under 8 Section 192.006(d)(2) must be from the list of alternate electors 9 described by Section 192.031(c) or 192.032(i). 10 SECTION 4. Section 192.008(a), Election Code, is amended to 11 read as follows: 12 In performing their official duties, presidential 13 (a) 14 electors and alternate electors are entitled to the same allowances 15 for travel expenses as those granted to state employees. 16 SECTION 5. Section 192.031, Election Code, is amended by 17 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: (c) The party's state chair may provide a list of alternate 18 19 electors for a vacancy created under Section 192.006(d)(2) in a number not to exceed the number of electors described by Subsection 20 (a)(2)(B). 21 SECTION 6. Section 192.032, Election Code, is amended by 22 23 adding Subsection (i) to read as follows: 24 (i) An independent candidate may provide a list of alternate 25 electors for a vacancy created under Section 192.006(d)(2) in a 26 number not to exceed the number of electors described by Subsection 27 (b)(2).
