- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 59, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 59.035 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 59.035. SEIZURE OF MONEY BY ELECTRONIC RECOVERY AND
- 8 ACCESS TO DATA PREPAID CARD READER PROHIBITED. (a) In this article:
- 9 (1) "Debit card" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 10 <u>502.001</u>, <u>Business & Commerce Code</u>.
- 11 (2) "Electronic recovery and access to data prepaid
- 12 card reader" means a handheld device that uses wireless
- 13 connectivity to check the balance of a debit card or stored value
- 14 <u>card.</u>
- 15 (3) "Stored value card" has the meaning assigned by
- 16 Section 604.001, Business & Commerce Code.
- 17 (b) A law enforcement agency may not use an electronic
- 18 recovery and access to data prepaid card reader to seize from a
- 19 stored value card or a depository account funds that are subject to
- 20 forfeiture under this chapter unless the seizure is authorized by a
- 21 search or seizure warrant.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
