10	(3) physically by an individual.
11	(g) A person, including a governmental entity, may not sell
12	a record filed or otherwise lawfully deposited with the clerk of a
13	district court unless the person has the express, written
14	permission of the clerk to sell the record.
15	SECTION 2. Section 51.303(g), Government Code, as added by
16	this Act, applies to a record filed or otherwise lawfully deposited

- 17 with a district court before, on, or after the effective date of
- 18 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 19
