1-22 relating to the authority of the asset management division of the
 1-23 General Land Office to sell real property to a federally recognized
 1-24 Indian tribe.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 31.0672(a), Natural Resources Code, is
 1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (a) The division may directly sell to a political
 1-29 subdivision, ~~or~~ a development corporation organized under
 1-30 Subtitle C1, Title 12, Local Government Code, or a federally
 1-31 recognized Indian tribe, as listed by the United States secretary
 1-32 of the interior under 25 U.S.C. Section 5131, any real property
 1-33 owned by the state that the legislature has authorized or the
 1-34 governor has approved for sale under Subchapter E if the
 1-35 commissioner determines the sale is in the best interest of the
 1-36 state.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
