7	(a) An officer shall issue a written notice to appear if:
8	(1) the offense charged is:
9	(A) speeding <u>;</u>
10	(B) driving with an expired driver's license
11	under Section 521.025;
12	(C) failure to obey a traffic-control signal
13	under Section 544.007;
14	(D) failure to stop at a stop sign under Section
15	<u>544.010;</u>
16	(E) failure to signal a lane change under Section
17	<u>545.104;</u>
18	(F) operation of a motor vehicle in violation of
19	the motor vehicle liability insurance requirement under Section
20	<u>601.191;</u> or
21	(G) a violation of the open container law,
22	Section 49.031 [49.03], Penal Code; and
23	(2) the person makes a written promise to appear in
24	court as provided by Section 543.005.

- 1 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 2 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 3 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 5 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 6 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 7 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 8 before that date.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
