5	SECTION 1. Section 415.035, Labor Code, is amended to read
6	as follows:
7	Sec. 415.035. JUDICIAL REVIEW. [ <del>(a)</del> ] A decision under
8	Section 415.034 is subject to judicial review in the manner
9	provided for judicial review under Chapter 2001, Government Code.
10	[(b) If an administrative penalty is assessed, the person
11	charged shall:
12	[ <del>(1) forward the amount of the penalty to the division</del>
13	for deposit in an escrow account; or
14	[ <del>(2) post with the division a bond for the amount of</del>
15	the penalty, effective until all judicial review of the
16	determination is final.
17	[ <del>(c) Failure to comply with Subsection (b) results in a</del>
18	waiver of all legal rights to contest the violation or the amount of
19	the penalty.
20	[(d) If the court determines that the penalty should not
21	have been assessed or reduces the amount of the penalty, the
22	division shall:
23	[ <del>(1) remit the appropriate amount, plus accrued</del>
24	interest, if the administrative penalty was paid; or

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## [(2) release the bond.]

2 SECTION 2. Section 415.035, Labor Code, as amended by this 3 Act, applies only to judicial review of a decision issued on or 4 after the effective date of this Act. Judicial review of a decision 5 issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 6 in effect on the date the decision was issued, and the former law is 7 continued in effect for that purpose.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
