A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to temporary branch polling place hours of operation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Sections 85.062(c) and (e), Election Code, are 4 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (c) In any election, the location of a polling place 7 established under this section and each voting station located in the polling place shall be fixed at one place for the duration of 8 9 the early voting period [that voting is required to be conducted at
- the polling place]. 10
- (e) In an election covered by Subsection (d), a temporary 11 12 branch polling place that is <u>located in a</u> movable <u>structure</u> may be established only with the approval of the county clerk. 13 14 [movable] temporary branch polling place is established in a movable structure on the request of a political party, each other 15 16 political party whose nominee for governor in the most recent gubernatorial general election received more than 10 percent of the 17 total number of votes received by all candidates for governor in the 18 election is entitled to establishment of such a polling place. The 19 election officers serving a polling place covered by this 20 21 subsection must be affiliated or aligned with different political parties to the extent possible. The secretary of state, after 22 23 consulting the state chair of each affected political party, shall prescribe the procedures necessary to implement this subsection.

- amended to read as follows: 2

- [IN POPULOUS COUNTY]. 4
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 85.064(b), Election Code, is amended to
- read as follows: 6
- 7 Early voting by personal appearance at each temporary (b)
- 8 branch polling place [established under Section 85.062(d)] shall be
- conducted on the days that voting is required to be conducted at the 9
- 10 main early voting polling place under Section 85.005 and remain
- open for at least: 11
- 12 (1) eight hours each day; or
- (2) three hours each day if the city or county clerk 13
- 14 does not serve as the early voting clerk for the territory holding
- 15 the election and the territory has fewer than 1,000 registered
- voters. [The authority establishing the temporary branch polling 16
- 17 place shall determine the hours during which the voting is to be
- conducted on those days. The authority shall order voting to be 18
- 19 conducted for the same number of hours that voting is required to be
- conducted on those days at the main early voting polling place under
- 21 Section 85.005 on receipt of a written request for those hours
- submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The 22
- 23 request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section
- 24 85.067.]

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- SECTION 4. Section 85.068(a), Election Code, is amended to 25
- 26 read as follows:
- 27 (a) The early voting clerk shall post notice for each

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- 1 election stating any dates and the hours that voting on Saturday or
- 2 Sunday will be conducted under Section 85.064(d) [or 85.065(b)], if
- 3 the early voting clerk is a county clerk or city secretary under
- 4 Section 83.002 or 83.005.
- 5 SECTION 5. The following provisions of the Election Code
- 6 are repealed:
- 7 (1) Sections 85.064(a) and (c); and
- 8 (2) Section 85.065.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
