6	is amended by adding Section 42.0533 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 42.0533. EMERGENCY PLACEMENT. (a) In this section,
8	"emergency placement" means the temporary placement of a child in a
9	foster home, foster group home, agency foster home, or agency
10	foster group home for less than 72 hours.
11	(b) The department and each child-placing agency with whom
12	children in the managing conservatorship of the department are
13	placed shall identify and compile a list of all licensed foster
14	homes and foster group homes or verified agency foster homes and
15	agency foster group homes that are able to accept the emergency
16	placement of a child when a safe and suitable long-term placement is
17	not available.
18	(c) The department shall collaborate with child-placing
19	agencies to:
20	(1) develop procedures for the emergency placement of
21	children; and
22	(2) increase the number of foster homes, foster group
23	homes, agency foster homes, and agency foster group homes that are
24	able to accept the emergency placement of children.
