## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the election of board members of certain emergency
- 3 services districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 775.024(c) and (h), Health and Safety
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) If the boards do not make the appointments before the
- 8 31st day after the date the boards adopted the joint order:
- 9 (1) for a consolidated district to which Section
- 10 <u>775.0343</u>, <u>775.0345</u>, or <u>775.035</u> does not apply, the commissioners
- 11 court shall appoint five commissioners to the board of the
- 12 consolidated district; or
- 13 (2) for a consolidated district to which Section
- 14 775.0343, 775.0345, or 775.035 does apply, the board of the
- 15 consolidated district is initially composed of the two
- 16 commissioners from each existing board who have served the longest
- 17 terms.
- (h) For a consolidated district to which Section <u>775.0343</u>,
- 19  $775.0345_{\underline{\prime}}$  or 775.035 applies, the initial commissioners of the
- 20 consolidated district serve until the next available uniform
- 21 election date after the date the joint order is adopted and that
- 22 allows sufficient time to comply with other requirements of law.
- 23 After an election is held under Section 775.0345 or 775.035:
- 24 (1) the two commissioners who receive the fewest votes

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- 1 of the elected commissioners serve terms ending on December 31 of
- 2 the second year following the year in which the election is held;
- 3 and
- 4 (2) the remaining elected commissioners serve terms
- 5 ending on December 31 of the fourth year following the year in which
- 6 the election is held.
- 7 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 775.034, Health and
- 8 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 775.034. APPOINTMENT OF BOARD IN CERTAIN DISTRICTS
- 10 [DISTRICT] LOCATED WHOLLY IN ONE COUNTY.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 775.034(h), Health and Safety Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (h) This section does not apply to a district located wholly
- 14 in a county:
- 15 (1) with a population of more than [three million;
- [(2) with a population of more than] 200,000 [that
- 17 borders Lake Palestine]; or
- (2)  $[\frac{3}{3}]$  with a population of less than 200,000 that
- 19 borders another state and the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 775, Health and Safety
- 21 Code, is amended by adding Section 775.0343 to read as follows:
- 22 <u>Sec. 775.0343. ELECTION OF BOARD FOR DISTRICTS IN POPULOUS</u>
- 23 COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a district that is
- located wholly in one county with a population of more than 200,000.
- 25 This section does not apply to a district described by Section
- 26 775.0345(a).
- 27 (b) The governing body of a district consists of a

- 1 five-person board of emergency services commissioners elected at
- 2 large from the district as prescribed by this section. Emergency
- 3 services commissioners serve two-year terms.
- 4 (c) After a district is created, the county judge shall
- 5 establish a convenient day provided by Section 41.001, Election
- 6 Code, to conduct an election to elect the initial emergency
- 7 services commissioners.
- 8 (d) To be eligible to be a candidate for emergency services
- 9 commissioner, a person must be at least 18 years of age and a
- 10 resident of the district.
- 11 (e) A candidate for emergency services commissioner on an
- 12 initial board must give the voter registrar of the county a sworn
- 13 notice of the candidate's intention to run for office. The notice
- 14 must state the person's name, age, and address and state that the
- 15 person is serving notice of intent to run for emergency services
- 16 commissioner. On receipt of the notice, the voter registrar of the
- 17 county shall have the candidate's name placed on the ballot.
- 18 (f) The voter registrar of the county shall appoint an
- 19 election judge to certify the results of the election.
- 20 (g) After the election is held, the voter registrar or
- 21 deputy registrar of the county shall prepare a sworn statement of
- 22 the election costs incurred by the county. The statement shall be
- 23 given to the newly elected board, which shall order the appropriate
- 24 official to reimburse the county for the county's election costs.
- 25 (h) The initial emergency services commissioners' terms of
- 26 office begin 30 days after canvassing of the election results.
- 27 (i) The board shall hold the general election for

- 1 commissioners in each even-numbered year on the November uniform
- 2 <u>election date under Section 41.001, Election Code.</u>
- 3 (j) Subchapter C, Chapter 146, Election Code, applies to a
- 4 write-in candidate for emergency services commissioner under this
- 5 section in the same manner it applies to a write-in candidate for a
- 6 city office under that subchapter.
- 7 SECTION 5. Section 775.0445(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 10 in a county:
- 11 (1) with a population of more than [three million;
- [(2) with a population of more than] 200,000 [that
- 13 borders Lake Palestine]; or
- 14 (2)  $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$  with a population of less than 200,000 that
- 15 borders another state and the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway.
- SECTION 6. Section 775.301, Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 775.301. DEFINITION. In this subchapter,
- 19 "commissioners court" means the commissioners court of a county
- 20 that borders the United Mexican States  $\underline{and}$  [ ${m au}$ ] has a population of
- 21 more than 800,000[, and appoints a board of emergency services
- 22 commissioners under this chapter].
- SECTION 7. Section 775.302(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- 25 (a) This subchapter applies only to a district that is
- 26 located wholly in a county that borders the United Mexican States
- 27 and  $[\tau]$  that has a population of more than 800,000  $[\tau]$  and for which

- 1 the commissioners court appoints a board of emergency services
- 2 commissioners under Section 775.034].
- 3 SECTION 8. (a) The changes in law made by this Act do not
- 4 affect the entitlement of a member of a board of emergency services
- 5 commissioners serving on the board immediately before the effective
- 6 date of this Act to continue to carry out the board's functions for
- 7 the remainder of the member's term of appointment.
- 8 (b) This Act does not prohibit a person who is a member of a
- 9 board of emergency services commissioners on the effective date of
- 10 this Act and who was appointed under Section 775.034, Health and
- 11 Safety Code, from running for election to the board if the person
- 12 has the qualifications required for a member under Section
- 13 775.0343, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 14 (c) A person serving as an appointed member of a board of
- 15 emergency services commissioners on the effective date of this Act
- 16 shall continue to serve until the election and qualification of a
- 17 new commissioner for that position.
- 18 (d) In 2018, the board of directors of an emergency services
- 19 district to which Section 775.0343, Health and Safety Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, applies shall hold an election to replace those
- 21 appointed commissioners whose terms expire January 1, 2019. A
- 22 commissioner elected under this subsection serves a term that
- 23 begins January 1, 2019, and expires 30 days after the canvassing of
- 24 the results of the initial general election for commissioners held
- in November 2020 under Section 775.0343(i), Health and Safety Code,
- 26 as added by this Act.
- (e) In 2019, the board of directors of an emergency services

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- 1 district to which Section 775.0343, Health and Safety Code, as
- 2 added by this Act, applies shall hold an election to replace those
- 3 appointed commissioners whose terms expire January 1, 2020. A
- 4 commissioner elected under this subsection serves a term that
- 5 begins January 1, 2020, and expires 30 days after the canvassing of
- 6 the results of the initial general election for commissioners held
- 7 in November 2020 under Section 775.0343(i), Health and Safety Code,
- 8 as added by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect June 1, 2018.
