A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to providing certain election information on the highway
- 3 changeable message sign system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 544.013, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) The Texas Department of Transportation in cooperation
- 9 with local governments shall actively manage a system of changeable
- 10 message signs located on highways under the jurisdiction of the
- 11 department to:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> mitigate traffic congestion by providing current
- 13 information to the traveling public, including information about
- 14 traffic incidents, weather conditions, road construction, and
- 15 alternative routes when applicable; and
- 16 (2) provide information regarding the date of an
- 17 <u>election</u> held statewide and the associated voter registration
- 18 deadline for the election.
- 19 <u>(c) The Texas Department of Transportation, in consultation</u>
- 20 with the secretary of state, shall establish a plan to provide the
- 21 information described by Subsection (b)(2) using the system of
- 22 changeable message signs managed under this section. The plan
- 23 established under this subsection must require the information
- 24 described by Subsection (b)(2) to be posted on the system in English

- 1 and Spanish for the following periods:
- 2 (1) two days before voting begins in the election
- 3 through the end of election day; and
- 4 (2) two days before the deadline for voter
- 5 registration through the end of the last day of voter registration
- 6 for the election.
- 7 (d) The plan established under Subsection (c) must also
- 8 require that the information described by Subsection (b)(2) not be
- 9 posted on a changeable message sign if the posting would interfere
- 10 with another safety or emergency alert, including an alert
- 11 providing information described by Subsection (b)(1).
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
