AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a school district to excuse from school 3 attendance a student who is exempt from the administration of a 4 final examination.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 25.087, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (b-7) and amending Subsection (d) to read as 8 follows:

9 <u>(b-7) A school district may excuse a student from attending</u> 10 <u>school during the administration of a final examination for a</u> 11 <u>course in which the student is enrolled if the school district</u> 12 <u>allows the student, because of a good attendance record and high</u> 13 <u>student academic achievement, to be exempt from the administration</u> 14 <u>of the final examination.</u>

(d) A student whose absence is excused under Subsection (b), 15 16 (b-1), (b-2), (b-4), (b-7), or (c) may not be penalized for that absence and shall be counted as if the student attended school for 17 purposes of calculating the average daily attendance of students in 18 the school district. A student whose absence is excused under 19 Subsection (b), (b-1), (b-2), (b-4), or (c) shall be allowed a 20 21 reasonable time to make up school work missed on those days. If the student satisfactorily completes the school work, the day of 22 23 absence shall be counted as a day of compulsory attendance.
