3	website of a state court and in the office of the court clerk.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 51, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.808 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.808. NOTICE OF SELF-HELP RESOURCES. (a) The clerk
8	of each court in this state shall:
9	(1) post on the court's Internet website, if any, a
10	<pre>link to:</pre>
11	(A) the self-help resources Internet website of
12	the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System
13	described in Subsection (b);
14	(B) the Lawyer Referral and Information Service
15	of the State Bar of Texas and any local lawyer referral service
16	serving the county in which the court is located;
17	(C) the Internet website of any legal aid or pro
18	bono organization that provides free legal services to indigent
19	persons in the county in which the court is located; and
20	(D) any court-affiliated self-help center
21	serving the county in which the court is located; and
22	(2) conspicuously display in the clerk's office in a
23	location frequently accessed by the public a sign with the
24	information described in Subdivision (1).

- 1 (b) The Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial
- 2 System shall develop and maintain a self-help resources Internet
- 3 website that includes information on and links to:
- 4 (1) the Lawyer Referral and Information Service of the
- 5 State Bar of Texas;
- 6 (2) the Referral Directory Legal Services and Other
- 7 Resources for Low-Income Texans of the State Bar of Texas;
- 8 (3) the State Law Library;
- 9 (4) the self-help website for this state's electronic
- 10 filing system;
- 11 (5) the programs and services section on the Internet
- 12 website of the supreme court; and
- 13 (6) any other self-help resource approved by the
- 14 office.
- 15 <u>(c)</u> The Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial
- 16 System shall prescribe the format for the information required
- 17 under Subsection (a).
- 18 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 19 of this Act, the Office of Court Administration of the Texas
- 20 Judicial System shall prescribe the format of the information
- 21 required under Section 51.808, Government Code, as added by this
- 22 Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
