- 8 (3-a) "Least restrictive setting" means a placement
- 9 for a child that, in comparison to all other available placements,
- 10 <u>is the most family-like setting.</u>
- 11 (3-b) "Physician assistant" has the meaning assigned
- 12 by Section 157.051, Occupations Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 263.001, Family Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 15 (c) With respect to a child who is removed from the child's
- 16 home, if a suitable relative or other designated caregiver is not
- 17 <u>available</u>, placing the child in a foster home or a general
- 18 residential operation operating as a cottage home is considered the

- 1 SECTION 4. Section 264.107, Family Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 (c) In selecting a placement for a child, the department
- 4 shall consider whether the placement is in the child's best
- 5 interest. In determining whether a placement is in a child's best
- 6 interest, the department shall consider whether the placement:
- 7 (1) is the least restrictive setting for the child;
- 8 (2) is the closest in geographic proximity to the
- 9 child's home;
- 10 (3) is the most able to meet the identified needs of
- 11 the child; and
- 12 (4) satisfies any expressed interests of the child
- 13 relating to placement, when developmentally appropriate.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
