- 6 SECTION 1. Section 12.104(b-2), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:

- 8 (b-2) An open-enrollment charter school is subject to the
- 9 requirement to establish an individual graduation committee under
- 10 Section 28.0258. This subsection expires September 1, 2019 [$\frac{2017}{1}$].
- SECTION 2. Sections 28.025(c-6) and (h-1), Education Code,
- 12 are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (c-6) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a person may receive
- 14 a diploma if the person is eligible for a diploma under Section
- 15 28.0258. This subsection expires September 1, 2019 [$\frac{2017}$].
- 16 (h-1) This subsection and Subsection (h) expire September
- 17 1, <u>2019</u> [2018].
- SECTION 3. Section 28.0258(1), Education Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (1) This section expires September 1, 2019 [2017].
- SECTION 4. Section 28.0259(e), Education Code, is amended

- (e) This section expires September 1, 2020 [2018].
- SECTION 5. Section 39.025(a-2), Education Code, as added by

- 1 Chapter 5 (S.B. 149), Acts of the 84th Legislature, Regular
- 2 Session, 2015, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (a-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a student who has
- 4 failed to perform satisfactorily on end-of-course assessment
- 5 instruments in the manner provided under this section may receive a
- 6 high school diploma if the student has qualified for graduation
- 7 under Section 28.0258. This subsection expires September 1, 2019
- $8 \left[\frac{2017}{1} \right]$.
- 9 SECTION 6. Section 39.025(a-3), Education Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (a-3) A student who, after retaking an end-of-course
- 12 assessment instrument for Algebra I or English II, has failed to
- 13 perform satisfactorily as required by Subsection (a), but who
- 14 receives a score of proficient on the Texas Success Initiative
- 15 (TSI) diagnostic assessment for the corresponding subject for which
- 16 the student failed to perform satisfactorily on the end-of-course
- 17 assessment instrument satisfies the requirement concerning the
- 18 Algebra I or English II end-of-course assessment, as applicable.
- 19 This subsection expires September 1, 2019 [2017].
- 20 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
