A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the engagement strategies included in a school 3 district's family engagement plan.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 29.168(b), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

(b) 7 The agency shall collaborate with other state agencies, including the Health and Human Services Commission, that provide 8 services for children from birth through five years of age to 9 establish prioritized family engagement strategies to be included 10 11 in a school district's family engagement plan. A parent-teacher 12 organization, community group, or faith-based institution may submit to the agency recommendations regarding the establishment of 13 14 family engagement strategies, and the agency, in establishing the family engagement strategies, shall consider any received 15 16 recommendations. The engagement strategies must [be]:

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be based on empirical research; [and]

18 (2) <u>be</u> proven to demonstrate significant positive 19 short-term and long-term outcomes for early childhood education<u>;</u> 20 <u>and</u>

21 (3) include programs and interventions that engage a
22 family in supporting a student's learning at home.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
