## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the disclosure of interested parties by business
- 3 entities contracting with governmental entities or state agencies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2252.908(a)(3), Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Interested party" means a person who has a
- 8 controlling interest, as defined by Section 171.0001, Tax Code, in
- 9 a business entity with whom a governmental entity or state agency
- 10 contracts or who actively participates in facilitating the contract
- 11 or negotiating the terms of the contract, including a broker,
- 12 intermediary, adviser, or attorney for the business entity.
- SECTION 2. Sections 2252.908(b), (d), and (f), Government
- 14 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (b) This section applies only to a contract that a business
- 16 entity enters into or seeks to enter into with [of] a governmental
- 17 entity or state agency that:
- 18 (1) requires an action or vote by the governing body of
- 19 the governmental entity or state agency before the contract may be
- 20 signed; and [<del>or</del>]
- 21 (2) has a value of at least \$10 [\$\frac{\pmathbf{\$}}{4}]\$ million.
- 22 (d) A governmental entity or state agency may not enter into
- 23 a contract described by Subsection (b) with a business entity that
- 24 does not have a disclosure of interested parties on file with the

- 1 Texas Ethics Commission [unless the business entity, in accordance
- 2 with this section and rules adopted under this section, submits a
- 3 disclosure of interested parties to the governmental entity or
- 4 state agency at the time the business entity submits the signed
- 5 contract to the governmental entity or state agency].
- 6 (f) A business entity subject to this section shall submit a
- 7 <u>disclosure of interested parties to the Texas Ethics Commission:</u>
- 8 (1) annually until expiration of the contract to which
- 9 this section applies; and
- 10 (2) not later than the 30th day after the date of any
- 11 material change in the interested parties previously disclosed by
- 12 the business entity under this section [Not later than the 30th day
- 13 after the date the governmental entity or state agency receives a
- 14 disclosure of interested parties required under this section, the
- 15 governmental entity or state agency shall submit a copy of the
- 16 <u>disclosure to the Texas Ethics Commission</u>].
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas Ethics
- 18 Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to comply with the
- 19 changes in law made by this Act.
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 21 a contract for which the request for bids or proposals or other
- 22 applicable expressions of interest is made public on or after
- 23 January 1, 2018.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
