- 12 each proper item of expense, is a first lien against that
- revenue. For a municipality with a population of more than one 13

- revenue of a municipally owned utility system that secures the 15

- this chapter also applies to funding, as a necessary operations 17
- expense, for a bill payment assistance program for utility system 18

- [have been threatened with disconnection from 20 (1)
- 21 service for nonpayment of bills and who] have been determined by the
